MidiEnglish

New MidiEnglish is an English program for children aged 4 to 12 years. The program comprises a series of thematic readers, storybooks, phonics readers, speaking and conversation readers, workbooks, interactive multimedia resources for teachers, and a student app that empowers children to learn progressively and independently.

























Learning Approach

MidiEnglish places an emphasis on reading and the enjoyment of the English language. Thematic readers and storybooks are used in place of traditional textbooks to enable children to gain skills in reading, listening, speaking, and writing. These reading materials introduce thematic topics and different text types to provide the context and content for children to think and talk about.



In addition, musical activities are built in to enhance understanding and memory of new knowledge acquired.

Apart from reading, children learn to decode the pronunciation of new words through the synthetic phonics approach (in lower

levels), acquire language-use skills through grammar lessons (in upper levels), and hone their conversational abilities through role-playing activities.

This multi-pronged learning approach enables learning of English both as a whole and in their parts, in a comprehensive and progressive manner that builds children's confidence in the English language.

By completing the 12-level program, children would acquire key language skills that correlate with Levels A1 and A2 of CEFR and Cambridge English.



The MidiEnglish program is fully supported by **multimedia software** for teachers' use in face-to-face lessons; **print** materials that include reading resources, cards and workbooks; and a home learning **app** that supports independent learning.



The multimedia PC software for teachers contains a comprehensive set of teaching resources including ebooks, songs, flashcards, lessons and interactive activities. Detailed lesson plans are also available to provide guidance to teachers who are new to the MidiEnglish program.


Home Learning App
